Her work has been published in *Time*, *Newsweek*, *The Economist*, *Der Spiegel*, *Stern*, *GEO* and *Men's Journal*. Commercial clients include Apple, Nike, Google, Facebook, Netflix and Microsoft, and she has also partnered with foundations and non-profits including NPR and the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

Deanne's documentary work was a finalist for the Alexia Foundation Grant for

World Peace in 2011. In 2012 she was presented with the Juror's Selection for the American Photography Awards, and in 2013 her work was selected for *Communication Arts* magazine's Photography Annual.

She has also received awards from Pictures of the Year International and NPPA Best of Photojournalism, and is a recipient of the Casey Medal for Meritorious Journalism.

Her images are part of the permanent collection of the Newseum in Washington, DC, as well as part of their traveling exhibition of Pulitzer-winning photographs.
